Historically a leading [seaport](#) of the area, the story of Mystic's nautical connection is told at [Mystic Seaport](#), the nation's largest [maritime museum](#), which has preserved a number of [sailing ships](#) (most notably the [whaler Charles W. Morgan](#)) and seaport buildings. The village is located on the [Mystic River](#), which flows into [Long Island Sound](#), providing access to the sea. The [Mystic River Bascule Bridge](#) crosses the river in the center of the village.

The starting time is 9:30am Sunday Morning and the place is the Howard Johnson Inn - Mystic, 253 Greenmanville Ave, Mystic, CT 06355, 860-536-2654 or 800-446-4656. At Exit 90 off I-95. Entrance is on the Right at the second light.



Participants receive a set of instructions to follow and information to collect. Similar to a scavenger hunt but more like a short road rally, participants follow clues to determine when and where to turn and what information to gather. Event planners usually include stops in one of New England's historic cemeteries. The run ends at a restaurant for lunch and to exchange stories.

If you are planning on coming to Mystic on Saturday the Howard Johnson Inn is offering special rates on rooms for this event: \$87.20 for King bed and \$95.20 for 2 Queen beds.
